22 This matter is before the Court on the United States' motion for summary judgment.  
23 Upon consideration of the motion and supporting materials, the Court finds that the undisputed  
24 material facts show that Defendant Bundy is in trespass in the New Trespass Lands, which lands  
25 are identified in Exhibit 1 of the United States' Motion for Summary Judgment. The United  
26 States' motion is GRANTED, and it is further ORDERED:

Defendant Bundy is permanently enjoined from trespassing on the New Trespass Lands;

The United States is entitled to a declaratory judgment that it is entitled to protect the New Trespass Lands against this trespass, and all future trespasses by Defendant Bundy;

That Mr. Bundy will remove his livestock from the New Trespass Lands within 45 days of the date hereof, and the United States is entitled to seize and remove to impound any of Defendant Bundy's cattle that remain in trespass after 45 days of the date hereof.

That the United States is entitled to seize and remove to impound any of Defendant Bundy's cattle for any future trespasses, provided the United States has provided notice to Defendant Bundy under the governing regulations of the United States Department of the Interior.

The Clerk shall enter judgment accordingly.
