36 Yogananda Street Sandyhook, Connecticut



**Action Taken:** On Friday December 14, 2012, between 2130 hours and 0845 hours the following four hundred and seventy two (472) digital images were taken as part of a homicide investigation being conducted in the town of Sandyhook, Connecticut by members of the Connecticut State Police, Eastern District Major Crime Squad.

The images attached depict 36 Yogananda Street, the residence of Nancy Lanza and her son Adam Lanza. The digital images were taken by Detective Daniel Cargill #550 of the Connecticut State Police Eastern District Major Crime Squad utilizing a Nikon D-300 digital camera and stored on a Verbatim 8GB SD card. The digital color images were taken from various angles and directions showing various the views of the residence and its contents.

The images were subsequently transferred to a "Memorex" DVD-R disc which is being held at the Connecticut State Police Eastern District Major Crime Squad Headquarters located at #401 W. Thames Street Unit #500 Norwich, CT. Copies of the DVD-R will be made as necessary for casebooks and reports as needed. The images were captured under the authority of a search and seizure warrant signed on 12/14/2012 by members of the Connecticut State Police Central District Major Crime Squad.
